We have received a fascinating article about the little houses in the Lavender Garden (which you can find in full on our website on the 'About the Park' page). The houses were originally made by Edgar Wilson in 1947 for Brockwell Park. Luckily for us he made too many and some were given to Vauxhall Park. Edgar Wilson had been very touched by the food parcels that were sent by the City of Melbourne in Australia, to London at the end of the Second World War so he made them a model village in

#### **PARKWATCH**



Now that we have lost both the gardeners based in the Park, and the Park Ranger service, we are in contact with the Metropolitan Police about setting up a Parkwatch in Vauxhall Park. We will need residents who overlook the Park and who can contact the police if they see anything happening, to volunteer to take part. Signs will go up around the Park advertising the scheme so hopefully the Park

will have some measure of protection. You should, of course, always call 999 if an incident occurs.
